# PROTOCOL AMENDING THE GENERAL SECURITY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE KINGDOM OF SWEDEN AND THE REPUBLIC OF ESTONIA CONCERNING THE PROTECTION OF CLASSIFIED INFORMATION

The Government of the Kingdom of Sweden and the Government of the Republic of Estonia,

DESIRING to conclude a Protocol to amend the General Security Agreement between the Kingdom of Sweden and the Republic of Estonia concerning the Protection of Classified Information, signed in Tallinn on 30 January 2002,

Have agreed as follows:

# Article 1

The definition of "Security Classifications" in Article 1 (Definitions) will be deleted and replaced by the following:

"Security Classifications" and their equivalents in the two countries are:

In the Kingdom of Sweden		In the Republic of Estonia

Estonian Classified Information marked as "PIIRATUD" and "KONFIDENTSIAALNE" will be protected by the Civil Authorities of the Kingdom of Sweden as Classified Information marked as "HEMLIG".

### Article 2

Article 2 (Competent Security Authorities) will be deleted and replaced by the following:

# "ARTICLE 2 COMPETENT SECURITY AUTHORITIES

The Government Authorities responsible for Defence Security in each country are the following:

# In the Kingdom of Sweden:

Armed Forces, Military Security Service (National Security Authority)

Defence Materiel Administration (Designated Security Authority)

# In the Republic of Estonia:

Ministry of Defence, National Security Authority Department (National Security Authority)

The Parties will notify each other through diplomatic channels of any subsequent changes of their competent security authorities."

## Article 3

Article 5 (Access to Classified Information) will be deleted and replaced by the following:

# "ARTICLE 5 ACCESS TO CLASSIFIED INFORMATION

Access to Classified Information will be limited to those persons who have a "need to know" and who are authorised in accordance with the national laws and regulations to have access to Classified Information of the corresponding security classification level."

### Article 4

This Protocol will enter into force upon signature of both Parties.

This Protocol is signed in Stockholm on 24 April 2012, in two originals in the Swedish, Estonian and English language, all three texts equally authentic. In case of different interpretation of this Protocol the English text will prevail.
