**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
THE ARGENTINE REPUBLIC
AND
THE COOPERATIVE REPUBLIC OF GUYANA
FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CONSULTATIVE MECHANISM ON
MATTERS OF COMMON INTEREST**

The Argentine Republic and the Cooperative Republic of Guyana, hereinafter referred to as “the Parties”;

DESIROUS of increasing mutual understanding and cooperation between both countries;

MOTIVATED by the desire to develop and strengthen friendly relations between the people of both countries;

WISHING to facilitate mutual beneficial cooperation;

CONVINCED that constructive and permanent dialogue on all aspects of bilateral relations and other issues of common interest is useful and can contribute to better reciprocal understanding between both countries;

Have agreed as follows:

ARTICLE 1

The Parties hereby establish a mechanism to carry out periodic high level consultations to review aspects of their bilateral relations and undertake to exchange views on international issues, interaction in the international arena and on issues of mutual interest.

ARTICLE 2

The consultations shall also focus on all aspects of the bilateral relationship between the Parties, especially in the areas of political, economic, commercial, scientific, technical, environmental protection, educational and cultural cooperation. These meetings shall be conducted at the level of Ministers/Senior Officials according to mutual convenience and agreement.
