AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA

AND

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF MADAGASCAR

ON

SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNOLOGICAL COOPERATION

PREAMBLE

The Government of the Republic of South Africa and the Government of the Republic of Madagascar (hereinafter jointly referred to as the "Parties" and in the singular as a "Party");

CONSIDERING that the expansion of scientific and technological relations would be of mutual benefit to the Parties;

DESIROUS of strengthening cooperation between the Parties in science, technology and innovation;

RECOGNISING the importance of science, technology and innovation for national, regional and continental economic development; and

RECOGNISING that this cooperation would further the development of the friendly relations already existing between the Parties,

HEREBY AGREE as follows:

ARTICLE 1 PURPOSE

The Parties shall cooperate to develop and deepen their scientific, technological and innovation relations in equal partnership and to the mutual benefit of their respective scientific, technological and innovation systems.

ARTICLE 2 COMPETENT AUTHORITIES

The competent authorities responsible for the implementation of this Agreement shall be—

- (a) in the case of the Government of the Republic of South Africa, the Department of Science and Technology; and
- (b) in the case of the Government of the Republic of Madagascar, the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research.

ARTICLE 3 OBJECTIVES

The objectives of this Agreement shall be to-

- (a) promote information and knowledge sharing about the Parties' policies relating to research, technological development and innovation;
- (b) promote the development of joint scientific and technological solutions in support of the Parties' developmental agendas; and
- (c) promote the emergence of scientific, technological and innovation research involving the Parties' industrial communities in support of creating knowledge economies for mutual benefit.

ARTICLE 4 MODALITIES OF COOPERATION

(1) In order to implement the objectives set out in Article 3, the Parties shall—

- (a) organise bilateral events bringing together experts from the Parties' academic, scientific, industrial and institutional circles to promote scientific, technological and innovation cooperation;
- (b) initiate exploratory missions by designated authorities, researchers and experts to develop joint programmes, projects and initiatives;
- undertake joint scientific and technological research programmes with emphasis on bilateral, trilateral regional and multilateral networking in areas of mutual interest;
- (d) promote the exchange of scientists, including doctoral and post-doctoral students, technical personnel and experts as part of programmes and projects; and
- (e) cooperate in respect of all other agreed programmes or actions and implement any other agreed cooperation modality.
- (2) As a rule, joint projects and programmes shall give rise to joint calls for proposals.
- (3) Cooperation actions referred to in this Article are subject to the availability of funds of each Party.

ARTICLE 5

EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION

- (1) For the implementation of the activities contemplated in Articles 3 and 4, the Parties may—
 - (a) share information about their policies and priorities with regard to research, scientific and technological development and innovation;
 - (b) promote the exchange of information, documents, books, journals and bibliographies between scientific libraries, scientific and technological information centres, and scientific institutions, especially through electronic information and communication networks; and
