Sir,

With a view to facilitating the payment of French social security sickness benefits to Italian seasonal workers in agricultural employment in France, I have the honour to propose that, notwithstanding article 5 of the General Convention of 31 March 1948 between France and Italy on Social Security, the social insurance system applicable to such workers should be established in accordance with the following regulations :

SOCIAL INSURANCE SYSTEM (SICKNESS BENEFITS) APPLICABLE TO ITALIAN NATIONALS
PERFORMING SEASONAL WORK IN AGRICULTURAL EMPLOYMENT IN FRANCE

Article 1

Italian workers performing seasonal work in agricultural employment in France shall receive benefits in respect of agricultural social insurance schemes under the conditions laid down by the Convention on Social Security concluded on 31 March 1948 between Italy and France. Notwithstanding the provisions of article 5 of that Convention, however, the payment of sickness benefits shall be subject to the special regulations set out below.

Article 2

Italian seasonal agricultural workers in France shall be entitled to sickness benefits under the French agricultural social insurance scheme during an initial period of employment, if they prove that they have been paid workers in agricultural employment at least two-thirds of the time that has elapsed since they entered France.
