Sir :

I have the honor to refer to recent conversations between representatives of our two Governments concerning the desire of the Government of the Union of Burma to purchase certain technical services from the Government of the United States. I am pleased to inform you that my Government has authorized me to propose that the two Governments agree upon the following terms and conditions under which the Government of the United States would provide funds with which to purchase such services in exchange for kyat funds to be used for the purchase of certain commodities in the Union of Burma.

1. The Government of the United States will provide funds not exceeding \$1,100,000 (one million one hundred thousand dollars) to pay during the period ending June 30, 1958 for the technical services of American technicians and for purposes of State Scholars and trainees stipulated in paragraph 5 below.

2. The technicians will be engaged by the Government of the Union of Burma on the basis of specific contracts to be entered into by the Government of the Union of Burma with the individual technicians or with commercial firms or universities for groups of technicians.

3. In accordance with subsidiary procedural arrangements

(a) the Government of the United States will upon receipt of a request from the Government of the Union of Burma make dollar payments to the technician or firm or university as called for in the contract, such payments to be made under a letter of commitment to be issued by the Government of the United States to the supplier of the technical services; or
