No. 4251. TRADE AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN ITALY AND DENMARK. SIGNED AT COPENHAGEN, ON 12 JULY 1957

The Italian Government and the Danish Government, with a view to regulating trade between their countries, within the framework of European economic co-operation, have agreed on the following provisions :

Article 1

The two Governments shall apply to goods originating in and coming from each of the two countries all measures taken or to be taken in accordance with OEEC decisions.

All liberalization measures taken or to be taken in accordance with such decisions shall therefore apply automatically to goods originating in and coming from Italy and Denmark respectively.

Article 2

The two Governments undertake to authorize the import or export, as the case may be, of the goods listed in schedules A² and B³ annexed to this Agreement, up to the values specified therein.

Article 3

Payments relating to reciprocal trade shall be settled in accordance with the provisions of the Payments Agreement signed at Copenhagen on 4 October 1950.⁴

Article 4

In order to promote the development of trade between Italy and Denmark, a Joint Commission composed of representatives of the two Governments shall be established.

The function of the Commission shall be to supervise the application of this Agreement and to make such proposals as may improve economic relations between Italy and Denmark.

The Joint Commission may meet at the request of either Party.

This Agreement shall enter into force on 15 July 1957 and shall expire on 14 July 1958.
