No. 4587. EXCHANGE OF NOTES CONSTITUTING AN AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF NORWAY PROVIDING FOR A CONTINUATION FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS OF CANADA'S NATO AIR TRAINING PROGRAMME WITH RESPECT TO AIRCREW TRAINEES. OSLO, 17 APRIL 1957

Excellency :

The Government of Canada has given careful consideration to the difficulties experienced by the Government of Norway in making the transition from training of Norwegian air crew students in Canada under NATO training plan to a suitable national training scheme, and has decided in the circumstances to continue provisions of a limited amount of Canadian training for a reasonable time. It is the understanding of the Government of Canada that the Norwegian Government is prepared to make a token payment of five thousand dollars per student pilot entrant and two thousand dollars per student navigator entrant while this arrangement is in force, and that at some mutually convenient time during the third year of this agreement, discussions will again take place on a bilateral basis on the need or otherwise of extending it for a further period.

In accordance with recommendations made by the Supreme Allied Commander Europe and discussed between the Chairman Canadian Chiefs of Staff Committee and your Chief of Staff at the meeting of the NATO Military Committee in Washington in October 1956, the Canadian Government will make available annually, training accommodation for 65 student pilots and 5 student navigators of the Royal Norwegian Air Force in Canada beginning with the quota year 1957-1958.
